HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Highway Commissioner Peach stated the Road District had done the following during the period of April 21st, 2011 to May 18th, 2011:

- On April 21st barricaded both sides of Old Lebanon-Troy Road due to water over the road. Reopened approximately April 30th
- Placed millings on shoulders, mailboxes and potholes on all the roads
- Cleaned culverts, picked up trash, picked up limbs and trimmed trees back to edge of right-of-way
- Replaced culverts on Weil Road, Hagemann Road, Albers Road and at the Sod Farm driveway on Hagemann Road. Ordered two culverts through Motor Fuel Tax that are 4 (four) foot in diameter and 40 (forty) foot long
- On April 27th stored 3 V-Boxes, all snow plow equipment and attachments until next season
- Had 3 (three) trucks inspected
- Brake repairs on 2004 International truck
