# NEW BUSINESS

Approval of the agenda for the Annual Town Meeting to be held on Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 P.M. at the O'Fallon Township Building. Highway Commissioner Downs said the new inspector for the Stormwater project wants it posted on the agenda; the O'Fallon Township Road District is a member of a MS-4 Permit Holder group which is required by the IEPA (Illinois Environmental Protection Agency). This means; every effort is made to keep the streams and stormwater drains pollutant free. A brief discussion followed.

Trustee Frank Morski made a motion to approve the agenda for the Annual Town Meeting with the addition of the MS-4 Stormwater information included and seconded by Trustee Doug Scott. Roll Call: Scott – aye, Morski – aye; Ahle – aye. Motion Carried.

Approval of the appointment to fill the remaining term for the Trustee position vacated by Gary Hursey. Two resumes were submitted; Nathan Hubbard and Mary Jeanne Hutchison.

Trustee Frank Morski made a motion to appoint Nathan Hubbard to fill the remaining term of Trustee and was seconded by Doug Scott. Roll Call: Scott – aye, Morski – aye; Ahle – aye. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Ahle informed the board of several items that recently came up and will be on the next agenda.

Sunrise Rotary submitted a hall rental request in June for a community service project called "PCs for People." They will receive items on Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup> at the Township, and box everything up. A truck will pick up all items on Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Sunrise meets here every Wednesday morning and they have access to the building so, there will be no need to pay a monitor for this. Ahle said he just wants to let Sunrise Rotary know if it will be alright. A brief discussion followed. All were in favor of the project.

Ahle received a call from State Representative Kevin Schmidt's office about having a "tire recycling" day in the parking lot mid to late July. It will be a free service for the public to drop off old tires from 9:00 A.M. to Noon. A tractor trailer is provided by the state to remove the tires. They will just be using the Township parking lot. A discussion followed. Ahle said it will be on the next agenda, but he needs to let the representative know ahead of time to get things going. All were in favor.

Lastly, Ahle said they received the annual dividend check from TOIRMA for \$2,700. It is usually around the same amount every year.
